

Workshop Presenter Job Description

(\$100 Stipend) **may be increased for 2023**

Purpose of the Position:

Depending on the camp schedule, present one three-hour workshop to entire camp (90 campers), two 2-hour or three one-hour workshops to 12 and 13-year-old girls during the week of Tech Trek. **The times may change for 2023, could be 90 minutes – work in progress.** We can be flexible, depends on what and who we get.

Presenter Selection Criteria:

Workshop presenters should be organized, prepared and have a disposition that reflects excitement for Tech Trek and STEM learning. Workshop presenters should have a good reputation in their workplaces, schools and/or communities as an involved STEM practitioner or educator and role model.

Responsibilities and Duties:

- Provide stimulating hands-on activities and STEM-focused course work
- Provide curriculum for and teach the workshop focused on a STEM-related subject once to all campers during the week of Tech Trek camp.
- Be familiar with camp schedule and activities
- Supervise students throughout workshop and provide a safe environment for all campers
- Ensure workshop materials and curriculum start and finish on-time
- Act as a good role model for girls
- Model an excitement and passion for STEM and motivate such an interest in campers
- Provide opportunities for all girls to be involved in workshop
- Encourage and appreciate effort, celebrate and share success

Qualifications:

- Experience teaching or working in a STEM field (multiple years preferred)
- Enjoy working with 12-13 year old girls
- Committed to STEM education
- Encouraging and motivating personality

Training:

- The Camp Co-Directors will provide training on camp policies and procedures and campus safety procedures.
